



Real Ale Tasting Notes

Young's Kew Gold 4.0% ABV

Inspired by hops grown at the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew. Young's beers have a long history with Kew Gardens and what better way to celebrate Kew's 250th anniversary, than with a fine cask ale. Brewed using the finest Styrian Golding hops to provide a well rounded floral and citrus flavour with hints of fruit, finished off with a dry, hoppy bitterness. 100% malt brew: Ale lager malt with Styrian hops. Tasting Note : Light, golden and full flavoured with a refreshing bite.

Tribute 4.2% abv

A Supreme Champion Ale of Cornwall as voted by CAMRA*, Tribute is a popular favourite with locals and visitors to Cornwall, as well as being a much sought after guest ale throughout the rest of the UK. It is brewed using specially grown Cornish Gold Malt and is a perfect accompaniment to chicken, gammon or fish. The ideal alternative to a fine white wine.

"Tribute is a magnificent example of a bronze coloured English bitter, with a rich aroma of biscuity malt and tart citrus fruit from the Willamette hops. Wells Bombardier uses only the most flavoursome part of the rippest, hand sampled English 'Challenger' and 'Goldings' hops to guarantee a delicious sultana fruit taste and a wonderful, spicy aroma. We also use more malt per pint than other premium bitters and our English 'Crystal' malt is carefully crushed, not ground, to deliver the rich flavour and deep copper colour for which Wells Bombardier is renowned.

Young's Bitter (3.7% ABV)

Young's Bitter shares the heritage of 175 years of brewing expertise. Today Young's Bitter is the fastest growing standard cask ale in England and Wales and is a 'Top 10' standard cask ale brand.

With high levels of awareness and popularity amongst ale drinkers nationally, Young's Bitter is a quaffable, 'sessionable' pint, whose lower ABV recognises the need for responsible drinking.
